Now I Know! builds on children's natural curiosity, in an exciting learning environment centered around big questions. Each new challenge takes learners through a staged process of inquiry, supported by varied real-world content including BBC **videos**. New language, new knowledge and new skills are learnt through exciting real-world tasks bringing measurable results at every stage. There are two versions of Level 1 - I Can Read (for kids who can read and write in Y1) and Learning to Read (for those who will be learning to read and write in Y1).

Metodology & Highlights

Inquiry Based Learning The idea of **inquiry-based learning** is based on an open-ended approach to learning guided by students through questions, research, and/or curiosity. It's based on the idea that both teachers and students share responsibility for learning.

Authentic BBC videos provide students with a wealth of authentic, educational, and age-appropriate material on all topics presented, empowering students to successfully communicate in English.

Big Questions provided as unit titles give meaningful context for conversation and language tasks.

Mapped to the Global Scale of English. GSE descriptors are used as objectives and for self-assessment in every unit, so it's easy to track progress.

Exam practice for PTE YL, CYL, Key and Preliminary exams. Can also be used with **Benchmark English**.

Formative assessment is about checking for understanding in an effective way to guide instruction. It's used during instruction rather than at the end of a unit or course of study.

Summative assessment the primary goal of a summative assessment is to help measure a student's achievement at the end of a dedicated course of study.



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How to Teach with Now I know

Digital Teaching

- ◆ **BBC** produced story videos, which highlight key language points in an engaging way. These video clips are on grammar spreads.

Face to face Teaching

- ◆ An additional component, which is a **Speaking** and **Vocabulary Book**, provides extra support in speaking by exploring lines of inquiry springing from the Big Question as well as exploring speaking strategies further.
- ◆ Regular speaking activities throughout the unit with opportunities for pair work and personalization allowing students to express their ideas as well as practice new language.
- ◆ Speaking strategies starting from Level 1 are focused on non-verbal communication such as body language, respecting others, and use of language.
