Hybrid, FTF, and digital	Presentation tool: This tool is helpful when it comes to providing a proper class flow and engaging your students, whether it is sharing your screen through your computer or using an interactive whiteboard in class. Keep students engaged by calling on them to participate in the tasks. Allow them to write on the interactive whiteboard in class or the virtual classroom screen with the annotation tool.
Hybrid, FTF, and digital	Use flashcards, posters, and realia to provide relevance to your vocabulary instruction. Prepare in advance, so your students can have the resources ahead of time. You and your students can also create digital flashcards in Quizlet.
Hybrid, FTF, and digital	To pump up your students' grammar knowledge, have them use the structures in context, there are plenty of opportunities throughout the lessons. Keep this in mind 💡. Allow them to use structures presented in the book by having them record video simulations of real-life experiences or recording dialogues to present in class. They can use Flipgrid or VoiceThread to record themselves and create a video community.
Hybrid, FTF, and digital	Promote values and 21st century skills by having students prepare and complete the projects in each of the units.
Students can interact in teams/pairs, or individually in class or in breakout rooms online.
